

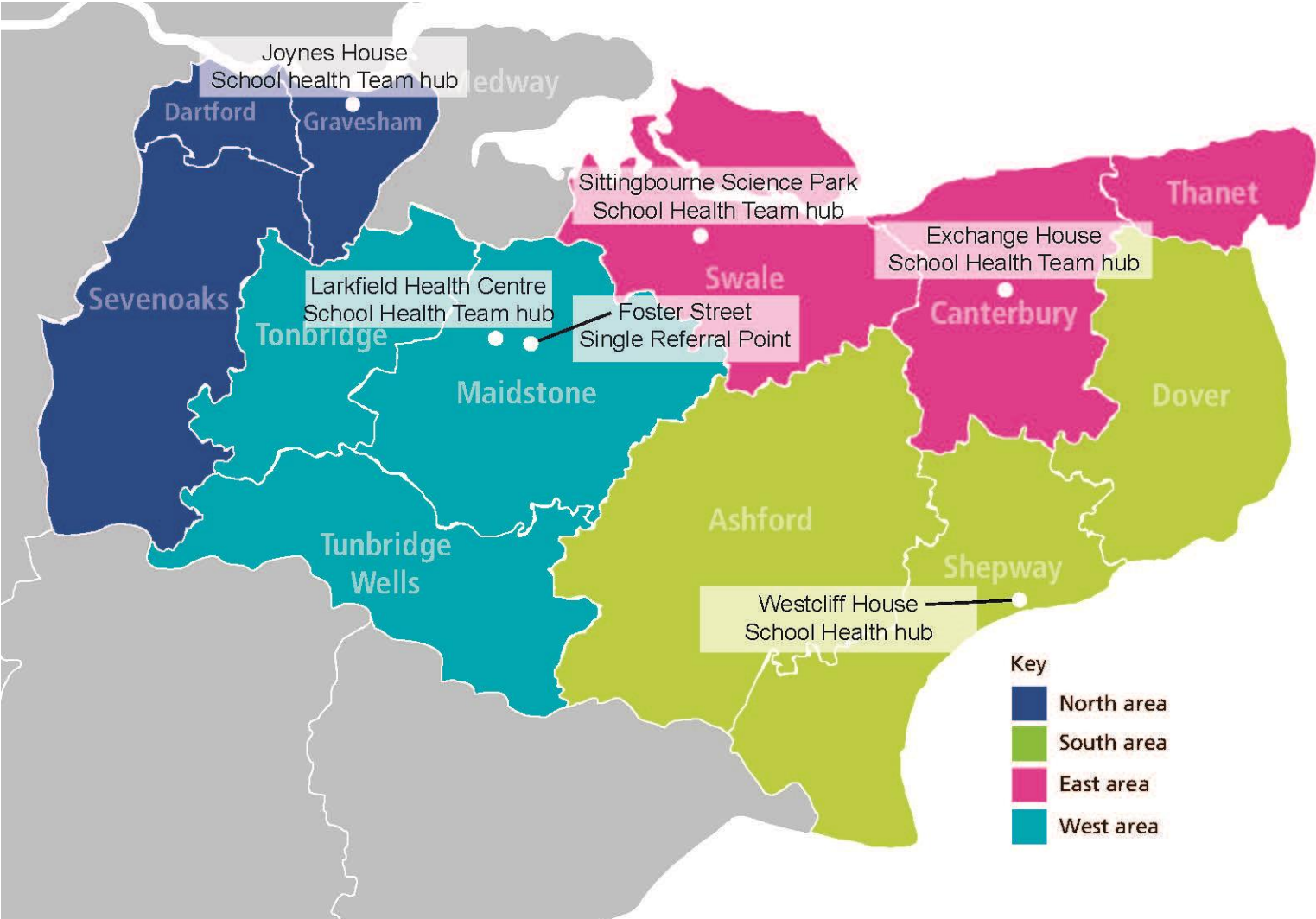

# Primary School Public Health Service

- **Health Assessments** at Year R and Year 6
- Tier 1 interventions for a range of health needs (including emotional wellbeing), and referral on to specialist services where necessary
- **Drop-in clinics** in schools for advice and information
- **National Childhood Measurement Programme (NCMP)** – weighing and measuring children in Year R and Year 6.
- **Vision and hearing screening** for Year R
- **Support for primary schools** in developing School Public Health Plans and delivering whole-school approaches to improve the health of their pupils.
