




Service locations





Primary School Public Health Service

- Health Assessments at Year R and Year 6
- Tier 1 interventions for a range of health needs (including emotional wellbeing), and referral on to specialist services where necessary
- Drop-in clinics in schools for advice and information
- National Childhood Measurement Programme (NCMP) weighing and measuring children in Year R and Year 6.
- Vision and hearing screening for Year R
- Support for primary schools in developing School Public Health Plans and delivering whole-school approaches to improve the health of their pupils.
