Mrs. Cannon “We have had a lot of fun and laughter since we began our art club. Starting on mark making on different materials, moving on to adding grounds to see the effect of different mediums have on the base textures, introducing colour to varied paper, card and grounds, working with charcoal and rubbers to make a picture. Pointillism with prime colours to explore how we can mix colour in dots and making art out of recycled materials to make a collages then adding another medium to the collage to produce unique textures. This term we are experimenting with modelling materials plasticine, clay, salt dough, paper-mache and soap. The young artists are shown the techniques and processes of how to use the materials and then have freedom to use their own.”
