Year 3 Term 4 - Stone Age to Bronze Age to Iron Age

Welcome to term 4, I hope you all had a very restful and relaxing break.

Our topic for this term is the continuance of Pre History from Stone Age to Bronze Age and Iron Age. We will be investigating the three different periods of the Stone Age period before moving onto the Bronze Age and Iron Age. We will be looking at how people lived, communicated, hunted, food storage as well as the important of Stonehenge and Skara Brae.



In science our topic is Rocks - comparing different rocks based on their appearance and simple properties and describing how fossils are formed and that soils are made from rocks and organic matter. If anybody has any fossils that they would like to show and tell the class all about, please feel free to bring them in.

be removed for the lesson and this is best done at home so they are not lost. Watches should also be removed for the lesson.

Home learning will continue to be times tables or the division aspect, spellings and a piece of English or Maths. If your child is struggling with the home learning or it is taking a long time to complete please let me know. Each piece of written or maths home learning should take no longer than 20 to 30 minutes.
