
Activity Audit November 2015



An audit of how active children are after school has been under taken.

- Only 54% of families have supplied information for the audit to date.
- Of these families, 46% swim after school and 27% play football either in school or at clubs.
- Of the activities shown, 57% are activities enjoyed by children in KS2.
- It was also found that children would like a tennis and street dance club in school.

To show how activity differs between girls and boys...

The school, at the time of the audit, the split of BOYs to GIRLS was 51% to 49%.

Girls are generally less active outside school than boys and therefore should be targeted with new clubs and afterschool provision.
