

Home Learning

This term we are going to trial a different style of homework. You will still need to learn your spellings and complete your Maths Passports, but the homework below will replace the weekly Maths and English homework tasks.

On Wednesday each week, you must hand in your homework book with at least one activity completed. Some activities are quicker to complete than others so you may be able to complete more than one.

This term we will have 4 weeks to complete homework, so by Wednesday 14th February you must have **at least 6** completed.

Give a short description of a Mayan / Central American tradition or festival.	Draw a graph to show average temperatures for Mexico each month of the year.	Calculate how long it would take to travel from Britain to Guatemala. List each stage of the journey.	Build a 3D model of a Mayan pyramid.
Design a new kit for the Mayan football team based on facts about the country and explain your choices.	Find out about School in Central America. Write a page about the school day and how it compares to ours.	Make a poster promoting a Mayan site as a tourist destination. You could include pictures, labels and diagrams.	Learn a Mexican dance- you could photograph or video yourself to show the class.
Cook Mexican food with your family - write down the recipe that you made and include a picture or review of it.	Research 5 cities in Central America. Why are they popular? Which one would you like to visit?	Draw a map of Central America. Locate the major mountain ranges, landmarks and rivers in Central America and draw and label them on a map.	Find the population of Mexico in 2017 how does this compare to The Mayans. How does this compare to Britain?
