



Year One: In Art this term the children are working on portraits and started by creating their own self portrait using a mirror to look at all the features of their face.



In D.T we are looking at Dips and Dippers. The children will have the opportunity to taste some dips and dippers and will then be designing, creating and evaluating their own products!

Year Two have been making houses from the Great Fire of London - from wood and straw. The children have also made a flame to attach to their houses so that during our assembly the houses can 'catch fire'.



Year 6 have created pictures of fairground rides and screen prints. We also have created clay discus work (ancient Greeks) and 3d sculptures for Sikh temple decoration.



Year 3 have been learning about Cubism through the artist Fernand Leger. We have researched some of his paintings and then designed and created our own cubism design on a mask. The children have created a wonderful board in the corridor. Please come in and have a look.

Year 4 have been making electric torches as part of their electricity work in Science.
