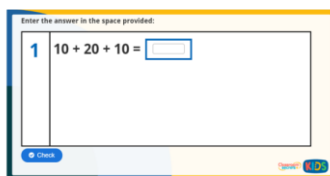

Year 2 SATs Arithmetic Revision Day 1



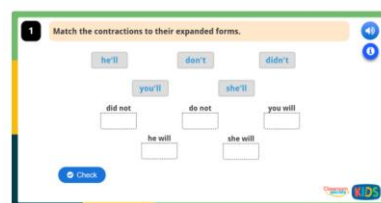

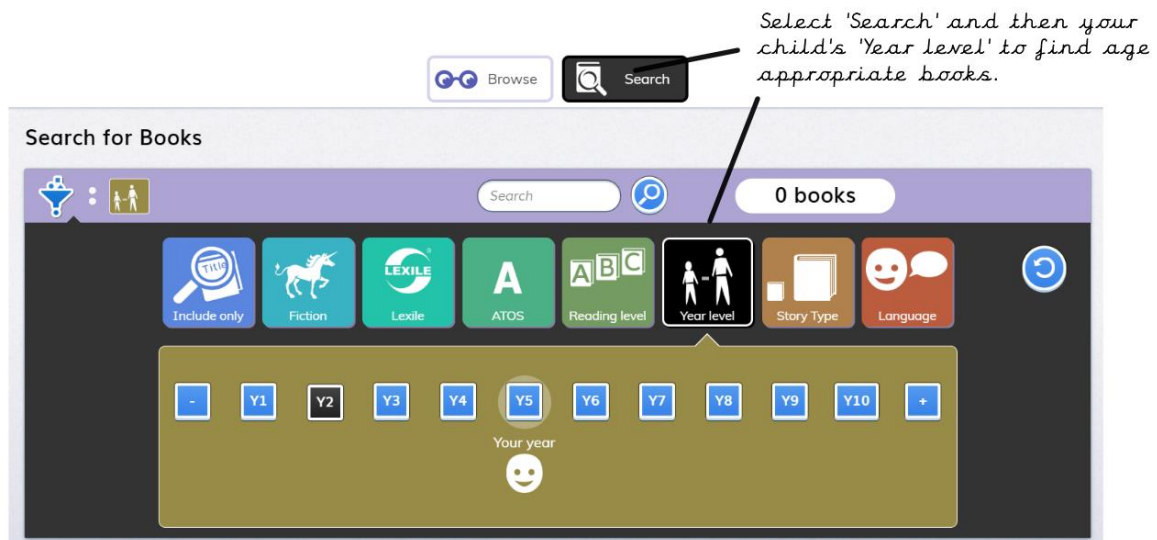
