- See if you can set up the experiment yourself to prove that light travels in straight lines. Take a photo of your test.

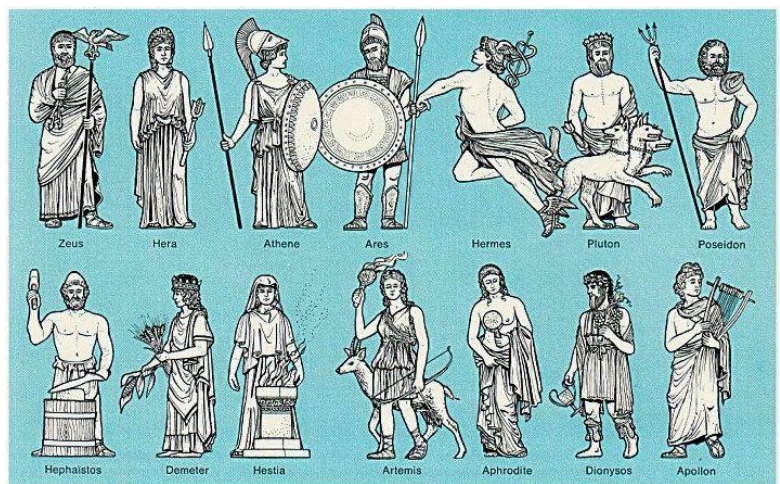
Topic Challenge
