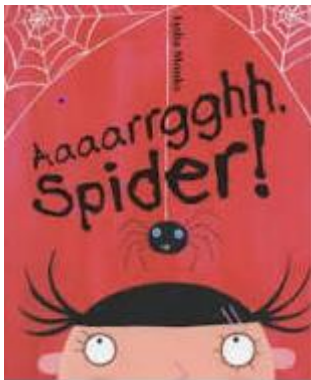

- Adding interesting pictures to the poster

Maths Challenge

Can you collect some different 'fat' 3D shapes? How many different shapes can you find? How are 3D shapes different to 2D shapes? Can you build a tower with all of the shapes?

You could focus on these questions:

- What other spheres can you find?
- Is a cube easier to build with than a cuboid?
- Can you describe a cylinder?
- How many sides does a pyramid have?

Go on a spider hunt outside with paper, pencils and a camera. What sort of spiders can you find and where do they live? Are they the same as the ones you may see in your house?

Can you do some research to find out more about spiders and to look more closely at what they look like?
