- Create a comic strip showing the story of Jupiter and the Bee with speech bubbles.
- Write a letter from the Bee asking the God Jupiter for a weapon, remembering use persuasive language.

Maths Challenge: Time

1. Make a mini fact sheet about how other areas of time are measured and how they relate to each other. For example days, weeks, months, seasons, years, decades, centuries and millenia. Find out which months are in each season and how many days are in each month.
2. Have a go at solving some or all of the problems:

Sarah is 7 years and 2 months old. Harry is 85 months old. Who is the oldest? Show your working.

Tara is going to Blackpool for a day. She has 4 hours 30 minutes there and can choose 3 activities to do while she is there.

Which activities could she choose to do? How much time would they fill? How many combinations of activities can you find?

Sea life Centre	125 minutes


- It is the 6th of November. Can you work out when Jan, Tim and Saira's birthdays are using the clues below?
