Can you find different ways to make 10 on the ladybird?

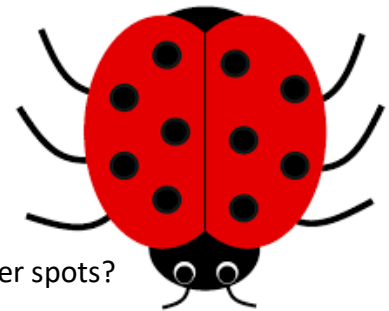
Can you make different addition sums?
