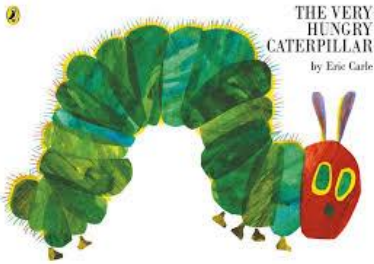


Week Beginning 18/05/2020

Can you make your very own hungry caterpillar? You could print it, paint it or make it!



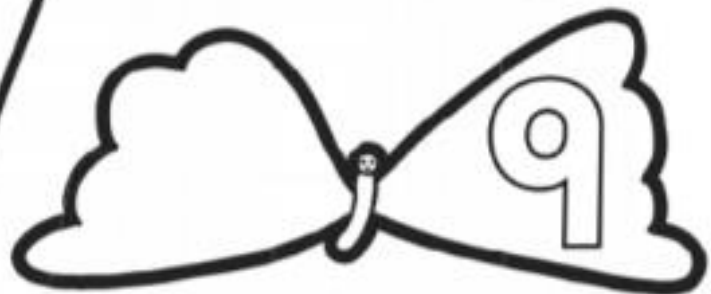
Roll, Add and Colour!

Instructions

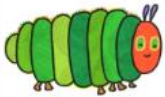
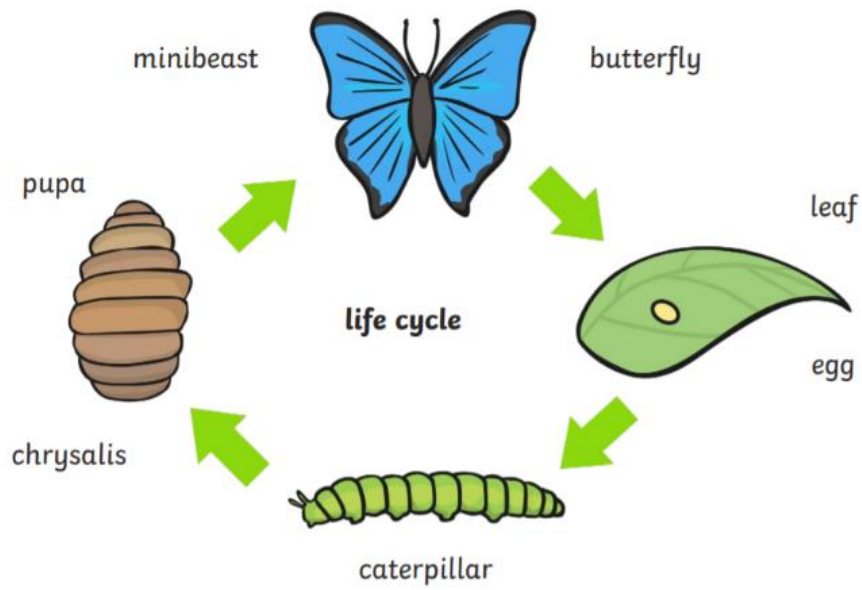
1. Roll two dice.
