It is of paramount importance that we safeguard the community from the potential risks of virus transmission and we therefore ask that, if your child is unwell, you communicate directly with us before sending them to school so that we can advise and support you. We do not want to risk the closure of any class bubble, as this is very disruptive - both to the children's education and to family life and parents' work commitments.
