

March 2021 Parent Consultation Meeting

Information for parents

Since the start of this school year, we have been teaching the curriculum content for your child's current year group. We have also been teaching a *Catch-up recovery curriculum* for the content missed during the school closure period March-July 2020; one third of the last school academic year. We have carried out a range of assessments each term to help identify areas of the curriculum that your child is secure in and where there are 'gaps.'

Now that all children have returned to school, our next formal assessment will take place after 6 weeks of first quality teaching; Term 5 week 4. Until then the children will continue with their year group curriculum lessons, *Daily recovery lessons in English & Maths* (which are in addition to their usual Maths and English lessons) and our extra catch-up intervention sessions for each class that are based on different areas of learning as directed by the class teacher.

Due to the national school closure period and subsequent disruption to in-school assessment this academic year, our revised formal assessment programme is detailed below:
